who bought Solomon Northup and owned him for 10 years. Northup's story inspired the 2013 movie "12 Years a Slave." Arrive in late afternoon at the **Paragon Casino Resort Hotel** in Marksville, LA for an overnight stay. Dinner and gaming money is *included* to enjoy at your leisure.

DAY 2 ★ FRIDAY, JUNE 23, 2017 ★ (B, D)

Buffet breakfast begins at 6:30 am in the casino's dining area. Bags should be packed and ready for pickup at 7:00 am. Meet in the lobby at 8:15 am for 8:30 departure for Baton Rouge. Upon arrival in **Baton Rouge** our Step-On Tour Guide will take us on a highlights tour that will focus on the rich African American heritage and history of the Capitol of Louisiana. Early afternoon you will leave Baton Rouge travelling into plantation country along River Road to New Orleans. Our highlights stop on today's tour is the **Whitney Plantation**. Whitney Plantation District is on the National Register of Historic Places. The site includes original historic buildings and structures that were rebuilt to their original appearance. Afterwards, tour members will check into the **Holiday Inn Superdome Hotel** for the next two nights. After a few minutes to relax and unwind, tour members are in for a treat this evening and a big "Welcome to New Orleans" at **Dooky Chase's Restaurant**, led by world famous 93 year old chef, Leah Chase.

DAY 3 ★ SATURDAY, JUNE 24, 2017★(B, D)

Buffet breakfast begins at 6:30 am in the hotel's dining area. Leave the hotel at 9:00 am with our knowledgeable **New Orleans** tour guide.
